Suggested Skill Level / Prerequisite: Intermediate with knowledge of peyote.

Class Description & Information:

Learn circular flat peyote as well as a few variations to make this elegant, lacy necklace. A button closure and reversible rivoli dangles complete this stunning piece.

Materials List: Basic beading supplies (beading mat, scissors, task lamp, glasses, etc) plus:

- 18 to 20 grams size 11 seed beads in a main color
- Size 11 seed beads in 3 to 4 colors, 5 to 7 grams each
- Size 15 seed beads in 2 to 4 colors, approx. 2 grams of each color.
- 9 to 12 size 12mm rivolis
- Japanese 3.4 drops or rose montees, optional
- Approximately 140 2mm round crystals (in varying colors)
- 4mm bicone crystals, approximately 40 (this depends on the amount of links you use)
- 3 to 4 small top drilled crystals drops for embellishing dangles
- Various crystals, pearls, glass, etc. for embellishing the dangles at the bottom
- One large button for closure
- Size 12 beading needle
- Thread of choice
- Thread conditioner or beeswax, optional
