Suggested Skill Level / Prerequisite: Intermediate - Knowledge of Peyote Stitch, some beading experience.

Class Description & Information:

A combination of beading techniques are used to create this stunning bracelet. Peyote stitch, a netting stitch, layering, and bead embroidery will be learned as well as playing with and thinking of new ways to choose a color palette.

Materials List: Basic beading supplies (beading mat, scissors, task lamp, glasses, etc) plus:

- Delica Beads, approximately 20 grams (or a bit more for a larger wrist) in 1 to 4 colors (or more if you prefer)
- Size 15 seed beads in 6 to 8 colors , 1 tube each will be plenty and you'll still have leftovers
- Size 3.4 Japanese Drops, as many different colors as you like. You will use less than 100 drops total
- 4mm Rose Montees, optional
- Cabochon, glass or stone
- Lacy's Stiff Stuff
- Double sided tape
- Ultra Suede (for the cab and a small piece for the closure)
- Metal Snap for the closure, the kind you find at a fabric store, size 1 or 2
- Thread of choice: Nymo, Silamide, C-Lon, Fireline, etc.
- Size 12 Beading Needle
- Beeswax or Thread Heaven, optional
